






Location chosen by large companies

Companies located in Alcobendas have an average of **7.8 workers**, **compared to an average of 4.4 workers** in the Community of Madrid.


The main reason is that Alcobendas is home to large companies, including 15 companies with more than €1 billion in revenue.

Number of companies with more than 1,000 million euros of income, 2018




Preferred destination for multinational companies with Spanish and foreign origin

Business City



Business HUB for the pharmaceutical, automotive and technology sectors

In terms of income, Alcobendas is the **second** municipality with the most **Pharmaceutical companies** in the Community of Madrid. Among these are important multinationals such as **Pfizer**, **Teva or Lilly**.

Alcobendas is also an **Automotive Hub**, being the **location chosen as headquarters** by some of the main brands such as **Ford**, **Renault**, **Mercedes-Benz**, **Toyota or KIA**. Having these companies in the municipality makes Alcobendas consolidate itself as the **second city in terms of income from** billing in the Automotive sector, being **five times higher than** the next municipality in the ranking of the Community of Madrid. This situation means that Alcobendas has a **beneficial fiscal framework** for the Automotive Industry, with **numerous IVTM discounts** (Tax on mechanical traction vehicles) for **large fleets of vehicles**, in addition to having a low IAE (business tax) coefficient and different discounts to promote employment.

Alcobendas is also a **Technology Hub**, being the preferred location for large multinationals such as **Indra**, **Samsung**, **Sage or Cisco**, which positions **Alcobendas in second place in terms of revenue** generated by technology companies in the Community of Madrid.

Alcobendas is committed to innovation and strives to become an international benchmark. In 2019, Alcobendas won the prestigious *Policy Hackathon Challenge in Silicon Valley*, with its proposal for an *Innovation Hub* for Alcobendas, based on the current business model and a future strategy, which will position the city as a destination for business development and innovation.





Generator of wealth



Municipality with the highest GDP per capita in the Community of Madrid

Alcobendas is the second city in the Community of Madrid that contributes the most to GDP.

With a figure of €70,879 per inhabitant in 2018, Alcobendas is the city with the highest GDP per capita in the Community of Madrid.

In terms of per capita income, the residential area of La Moraleja has one of the highest values in Spain, with an income of €29,364 per capita and €89,015 per household in 2018.


Growth potential in established hubs

One of the industries with the best **growth** prospects after Covid-19 is the **technology sector**, in which Alcobendas stands out as a **first-class Hub**.

Growth in Spain of 2.5% in 2021 and 3.8% in 2022 is expected for the programming, computer consulting and information services sector.



Good relationship between companies and administration



Close relationship between companies and the City Council

A good relationship between companies and the administration is one in which measures are taken and companies are listened to, providing them with greater agility in management, gaining in practical terms and efficiency.

Alcobendas City Council has been **awarded numerous prizes**, among them the **most transparent City Council and Ambassador of European Excellence 2019**, by the Management Excellence Club.

Close relationship between companies and the City Council.

They are organisations such as the **Association of Entrepreneurs of Alcobendas or Alcobendas Hub** that facilitate communication between public and private entities and quide companies that decide to settle in Alcobendas.

We value very positively the closeness between the companies and administration of Alcobendas, the ease of administrative procedures and the existence of a Hub that helps the installation.




Tax framework aimed at job creation



Low tax pressure

Compared to other municipalities, Alcobendas offers a low fiscal pressure:



Taxation geared towards job creation

Fiscal framework focused on job creation, especially the creation of youth **employment** through **IAE** (business tax) bonuses for increases in the workforce with **an indefinite** contract for workers **under 35 years of age**.

Due to the signing of the **Agreement for the Promotion of Employment** and as a mechanism to reduce the number of unemployed persons, the City Council offers an **IAE** (business tax) discount together with other benefits (eg transport voucher for workers). The agreement implies that companies must make **use of the municipal employment agency, for selection processes.**

Wide variety of transportation options



The City of Alcobendas has excellent connections with Madrid and the rest of Spain

4 Metro stations

Connection with Madrid through **4 stations on Line 10**, which crosses Madrid from Southwest to North.

Metro Line 10 stops at Plaza Castilla, one of the **main interchanges** in Madrid, as well as Nuevos Ministerios and Príncipe Pío.


Excellent commuter connection

Alcobendas has **two commuter train stations on the C-4 line**, connecting the **north and south of Madrid**, and with a stop at **the main AVE station: Madrid Puerta de Atocha**

Madrid Puerta de Atocha is the hub of the more than 3,100 km of High Speed Rail Networks in Spain.

41 bus lines

In addition, the city has 8 urban lines, 30 interurban bus lines (connecting Alcobendas with the centre of Madrid, the airport and the North of the Community of Madrid), 3 night bus lines and inter-company transport lines of the AICA Business Association.










Alcobendas is 10 minutes from Madrid-Barajas Adolfo Suárez Airport – the largest airport in Spain, and the fifth in Europe

Castellana Norte District



Alcobendas, closer to Madrid than ever

The development of the Castellana Norte District will create a new area as an extension of the Paseo de la Castellana, which will end 500 m from Alcohendas.


Improved access to Alcobendas

The works on the A-1 will be used to minimise rush-hour traffic jams (these will also be reduced with the improvement of public transport).

Better connections with Madrid and the rest of Spain

The Castellana Norte District Project will improve connections between Madrid and Alcobendas with the opening of two new metro and commuter stops in Fuencarral and the creation of a priority bus lane parallel to the A-1.

With the project, the **Chamartín station gains importance**, including high-speed connections with the north of Spain.





Efficient business parks in sustainable environments



Energy efficient buildings

The office buildings of Alcobendas score an average of **B+ high** on the ranking of **energy efficiency**, while those of the Moraleja score with **B-.**

This ranking classifies the **most energy efficient buildings as A, and G as the least efficient.** The main efficiency indicators used in the ranking are: **annual carbon dioxide emissions, and annual non-renewable energy consumption.**

Offices located in sustainable environments

Alcobendas has office parks located around **green areas**, such as the **Valdelacasa Business Park** located very close to the **protected area of Monte de Valdelatas** (89 hectares of protected forest). The business park has mostly unbuilt lots, offering ample opportunities close to a green environment.



Efficient business parks in sustainable environments



La Moraleja Business Park

It has offices and coworking centres.

The area has the Moraleia Green Shopping Centre with restaurants, shops and cinemas.

Arrovo de La Vega Business Park

It includes the Diversia leisure centre and the La Moraleja metro stop.

The northern part includes the Arroyo de la Vega park and the Eurostars Gran Madrid Hotel.

Alcohendas Industrial Estate

It has industrial warehouses and offices.

It includes several restaurants in the area, several department stores (Decathlon, Carrefour, Leroy Merlín) and the La Granja Metro stop.

It also has a municipal sports centre nearby.

Casablanca Industrial Estate

The area is surrounded by numerous parks and green areas.

It has restaurants, supermarkets (Dia and Lidl) and sports

Less than a 15 minute walk to a commuter stop.

Composed of 31.000 m2 of modular offices spread over

Valdelacasa Industrial Estate

It is mostly unbuilt, so there is room for growth.

To the north, the new Alcobendas (Los Carriles) is being built.

To the west is the Monte de Valdelatas, which is a protected area.

It has several restaurants in the area and the La Granja metro stop.

Omega Business Park

It includes several restaurants, the Hotel Madrid Congress and a sports centre.










Last Mile Logistics Centre



Alcobendas as the last mile

According to Knight Frank, Alcobendas and SS de los Reyes are the towns in Madrid with the highest e-Commerce ratio, making Alcobendas a location of growing interest for last-mile logistics in the north of Madrid.

Proof of this is the **logistics warehouse that Amazon has in the Valdelacasa Industrial Estate**. The warehouse has an area of 15,000 m2 and its objective is to shorten delivery times.

Companies such as GLS, Tipsa and MRW also have smaller distribution centres, and it is the city chosen by companies such as Grupo Akay, leaders in the last mile service of bulky products in the Iberian Peninsula..

Intelligent Urban Lab

The centre aims to facilitate access to innovation through new technologies, and inter-business collaboration and public-private cooperation. Its first project will be focused on improving mobility in Alcobendas through innovation.

Its purpose is to promote the transfer of knowledge between the Autonomous University of Madrid (UAM) and companies, with a special focus on R&D activities among SMEs. To achieve this objective, the UAM maintains a union with the main nearby business associations: AICA (Alcobendas), ASEYACOVI (Colmenar Viejo), ACENOMA (San Sebastián de los Reyes) and AETC (Tres Cantos).






15.51 m² of public **green areas per inhabitant**, a number higher than the national average.

By car, Alcobendas is 25 minutes from Puerta del Sol, 3 hours from the coast of Valencia (Eastern Spain), 3 and a half hours from Bilbao (Northern Spain) and less than 30 minutes from the mountains of Madrid.

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








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
